

SUNRIVER GOLF PASS RULES & REGULATIONS

These Rules & Regulations of the Meadows and Woodlands golf courses are designed to enhance the quality of Sunriver Resort and the services and facilities provided to its Golf Pass Holders and guests. All Golf Pass Holders and guests must cooperate with and adhere to these Rules and Regulations. Resort Golf Management may change the Rules and Regulations from time to time.

CLUB AND FACILITY

- Etiquette
 - All employees, members, golf pass holders and guests are under the supervision of Resort Golf Management and no member, golf pass holder, family member or guest shall reprimand, discipline, or abuse, verbally or otherwise, any employee, member, golf pass holder or guest. Any employee, member, golf pass holder or guest not rendering courteous and appropriate behavior should be reported to Resort Golf Management immediately.
- Alcohol Consumption (Oregon Liquor Control Commission)
 - Alcoholic beverages will not be served or sold, nor permitted to be consumed, on the premises during hours prohibited by law. No alcoholic beverages will be sold or served to any person not permitted to purchase under the laws of the State of Oregon. All alcoholic beverages consumed or otherwise possessed on the premises of the Resort must be sold and purchased at the Resort. Outside alcohol is prohibited including, but not limited to, homeowners, Golf Pass Holders, Members and their guests, guests of Sunriver Resort, and guests of Resort Golf Management.
- Gratuity
 - Tipping is allowed. Guest service, starter, teaching professional, player assistant, and food & beverage staff may accept gratuity.
- Commercial Advertisements
 - Commercial Advertisements, political posters, petitions, and other signage shall not be posted or circulated in the Resort's facilities without the prior approval of Resort Golf Management.

GOLF COURSE(S)

- Golf Course Hours
 - The hours of golf course play, practice facility hours, and golf shop hours are subject to change depending on golf course and weather conditions. The golf professional, in consultation with the golf maintenance staff, shall determine when the golf course is playable and such decision shall be final and binding on all persons using the golf course. No golf course play shall be permitted during any period that the course is closed.
- Reservations
 - All players must be assigned a tee time through the golf shop. Tee times may be reserved by calling golf reservations during golf shop hours.
 - The golf shop shall be notified of all cancellations at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled tee time. Failure to so notify the pro shop may result in a cancellation fee being charged to the member credit card on file of the responsible Golf Pass Holder equal to the amount of guest of Golf Pass Holders greens fee.
 - No more than one tee time may be reserved per day per member without prior approval by the golf professional.
 - Twosomes and singles may be grouped with other players, if available and if necessary, determined by the golf staff. Fivesomes will not be permitted to play without the permission of the golf professional.

- Registration
 - All golfers must register at the golf shop. All applicable guest, golf cart and greens fees must be paid at the golf shop before beginning play.
- Proper Attire
 - Acceptable attire for men includes slacks, appropriate length golf shorts, and shirts with collars at least 1" in width. Unacceptable attire includes denim, tank tops, cut-offs, sweat pants, bathing suits, tennis shorts, or other athletic shorts.
 - Acceptable attire for women includes dresses, skirts, slacks, golf skirts, and appropriate length shorts. Unacceptable attire includes denim, halter-tops, tank tops, bathing suits, sweat pants, tennis shorts, or cut-offs.
- Music
 - Listening to music or a broadcast is not allowed at the practice facility.
 - Listening to music or a broadcast while on the golf course is allowed. Speaker volume must remain on a low setting as to not be heard more than 15 feet from the golf cart or player's bag. Speaker must remain in the golf cart or attached to the players bag at all times. Etiquette must be observed by asking other players in the group if they approve. If they approve inquire about what type of music they like. If they do not approve refrain from listening to music during the round of golf.
- Golf Carts
 - The use of golf carts on the golf course may be mandatory for all players during certain hours.
 - Golf Pass Holders will pay the cost to repair or replace any property damage caused by their operation of a golf cart.
 - Golf carts provided by the Resort are restricted to use on the golf course and practice areas. No golf carts owned by the Resort shall be removed from the Meadows & Woodlands facilities at any time or be used on any road or bike pathway unless otherwise permitted by Resort Golf Management.
 - During required periods, determined by Resort Golf Management, golf carts shall remain on the cart paths.
- Practice Facility
 - Range balls are not allowed to be removed from the practice area. Range balls found on the golf course should be returned to Resort Golf Staff.
- Pace of Play
 - All players shall maintain a reasonable rate of play. In partnership with the USGA, Resort Golf Management encourages pace of play by its members and golf pass holders so that under normal circumstances, a round of golf may be completed within 4 hours and 15 minutes including any time stopping between nines. The golf staff may monitor pace of play through GPS software and the efforts of a player's assistant during the hours of play. No group shall be authorized to by-pass other groups at any point without prior authorization from Resort Golf Management.
- Golf Course Use
 - Jogging, bicycling, recreational walking, and walking of pets are not permitted on the golf course or cart paths at any time unless otherwise permitted by Resort Golf Management.
 - All play shall start at the number one tee unless permission to start elsewhere is obtained in advance from the golf professional staff. All players must check in with the starter. Under no circumstances shall players start play from residences surrounding the golf course unless otherwise permitted by Resort Golf Management.
 - No practice will be permitted on the golf course.
 - All players shall repair ball marks on greens and smooth sand traps before moving to their next shot. Divots must be replaced then filled with sand on the fairways and tees. Divots must be replaced in the rough. Divots deemed ruined must be discarded outside of the General Area.

- Restrooms
 - Resort restrooms are located in the main lodge and Woodlands Clubhouse.
 - Golf course restrooms are located behind hole 4 green and left of hole 13 green at the Meadows. Restrooms on the Woodlands are located left of 5 green and behind 15 tee.
 - Utilizing an alternative area as a restroom on Resort property is not permitted. If observed by Resort Golf Staff, anyone utilizing an alternative location as a restroom area will be removed from the golf course and subject to sanctions.

SANCTIONS, SUSPENSIONS, & EXPULSIONS

- Golf Pass Holders failing to adhere to the Rules and Regulations of the Resort may be subject to sanctions, suspension and/or expulsion. Visitors failing to adhere to the Rules and Regulations are subject to expulsion from the Resort premises at the sole discretions of Resort Golf Management.
 - Upon first violation, Golf Pass Holder will receive a formal letter from Resort Management explaining the violation and putting them on notice.
 - Upon second violation, Golf Pass Holder is subject to a 30-day suspension.
 - Upon third violation, Golf Pass Holder is subject to cancellation.
 - During a suspension, use of Meadows & Woodlands facilities is prohibited.

LIABILITY

- Golf Pass Holders, family members and guests shall use the Resort’s facilities at their own risk and shall assume sole responsibility for their personal belongings. Resort Golf Management, its members, officers, employees, representatives and agents shall not be held liable for personal injury to any person nor for loss or damage to personal belongings used or stored on the Resort’s premises. Each Golf Pass Holder shall be legally and financially responsible for his or her acts or omissions, as well as those of such Golf Pass Holders family members and guests. Each Golf Pass Holder shall indemnify and hold Resort Golf Management and its members, officers, employees, representatives and agents harmless from any loss, cost, claim, injury or damage incurred by the Golf Pass Holder or such Golf Pass Holders family members or guests arising out of the conduct of such Golf Pass Holder, family member or guests.

Resort Golf Management may establish additional rules and modify or rescind these existing Rules and Regulations for Sunriver Resort from time to time as Resort Golf Management determines to be appropriate for the Resort or its facilities. Decisions made by Resort Golf Management regarding the interpretation and application of these rules shall be final.
