AWOS: 128.325

Seattle Center: 126.15

Flight Service: McMinnville Radio 122.5

Runway: 18-36, 5,460' long, 75' wide with full-length parallel taxiway

Lighting: Lighted wind tee & rotating beacon. VASI on RWY 18, and medium intensity pilot-controlled runway lights (5 clicks on 122.8)

Parking: 55 GA T-Spots that can accommodate any aircraft under 10,000lbs

8 Jet Spots

2 Helicopter parking pads

Fuel: Full Service and Self-Service EPIC 100LL and Jet A

Terminal Building: Lobby Open 24/7, Restrooms, Wi-Fi, Telephone, and Flight Planning Computer

Rental Cars: Enterprise vehicles available for reservation with advanced notice

Courtesy Car: Available on a first come first serve basis for pilots

Airport is Open Everyday

Size and Type of Aircraft: Can accommodate aircraft as large as a Global Express and as small as a Cessna 120.
